Market Overview

Avocadoes

Price is up as MX winds down Quality is good. #2 (item# 137) & 60 ct (item# 136) are great cost savings to 48 ct.

Artichokes

Supplies are steady and quality is good.

Asparagus

Good supplies out of MX and CA. Price is off.

Broccoli, Cauliflower, & Celery

Broccoli – Product is beginning to come in from Salinas Valley but price is up slightly during the transition from the desert.

Cauliflower, Celery – The rainy weather has brought prices up slightly.

Leaf Items

Price is up slightly across the board due to the rain. Quality may be slightly off over the next week or so.

Melons

Honeydew, Cantaloupe – Honeydew are a better option than cantaloupe; 15 and 18 counts are scarce.

Watermelon – Price is coming off.

Tomatoes

Slicing/Romas – Romas are a better option to the slicing tomatoes this week.

Grape & Cherry – Production is slowing as field's transition. Keep an eye on quality like soft and split fruit.

Heirlooms – Product out of MX looks very nice.

Citrus

Lemons – Ventura crop is in and price is steady.

Limes – Price is up slightly and may hold through March/April. Higher counts are a better value.

Berries

Straws – Quality is great across the board and we have great local options.

Black – Quality is good on MX product.

Blues – Chilean product is steady and quality is good.

Squash

Yellow Squash – Quality is down and prices are coming up.

Zucchini – Quality is down and prices are coming up.

Peppers

Red/Yellow/Orange – Quality is excellent and price is steady.

Green – Quality is good. Sizes are running on the smaller side.
