Bad News

- **Berries** – Prices are escalated across the board. Wet and cold weather has hurt supply. Blackberries are the best buy right now.
- **Herbs** – Supply has been poor due to very cold/wet weather. Basil, arugula, cilantro, rosemary, and thyme have been the hardest hit. Shortages may happen, we will be sourcing for best quality.
- **Baby Kale Blends** – Heavy rains from last week damaged quite a bit of the main crop. High demand for this product means we may see shortages/firm prices. 1-2 weeks to recover.
- **Mushrooms** – US supply is way down due to weather impacts. Affects will last for months.
